Themes

Submissions on the below mentioned upcoming areas of law are invited-

Note: *Authors must refrain from giving political inclination to their articles.*

Eligibility

Law students and law aspirants having an interest in the field of law and related disciplines, can submit their *original* and *unpublished* manuscripts.

Submission Guidelines

1. Types of Submissions Accepted-

Legitosity accepts submissions of manuscripts in the following categories:

- I. **500-1000 words**, including maximum 100 words abstract.
- II. **1,000-2,000 words**, including maximum 200 words abstract.
- III. **2,000-3,000 words**, including maximum 300 words abstract.

Note: *The word limit is exclusive of footnotes.*

2. The title of the article should be appropriate and precise.
3. Abstract should form part of the article.
4. The paper shall be original and unpublished.
5. The paper should not be plagiarized, and free from grammatical, spelling and other errors.
6. There is no specific citation style. However, there should be consistency in the footnotes.
7. Co-authorship is allowed subject to a maximum of two authors (authors can be from different institutes).
8. Full names of the authors along with designation and contact number(s) must be given in the body of the mail and should not be included in the body or abstract of the paper.
9. The body of the paper shall be in **Times New Roman, font size 12, 1.5 line spacing and justified**. The footnotes shall be in **Times New Roman, font size 10, single line spacing and justified**.
10. The paper shall be in MS Word Format.
11. The work, upon publication, becomes a property of LSAC Global for which a consent form will be shared.
